- You were followed in an insistent and disturbing manner
- Someone showed you his private parts when you didn't want to
- You have been subjected to gender-based insult
- You have been subjected to insistent rubbing or touching on private parts
- Someone attempted to rape you or raped you.

Whatever the circumstances under which it happened, YOU ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR IT.

The only responsible person is the aggressor.

These behaviours are PUNISHED by law, you can file a complaint.

YOU CAN SEEK HELP FROM ARMADA'S PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION TEAMS BY CONTACTING:

First aid teams (Civil Protection, Red Cross) and medical station

They will be able to listen to you, advise you on the action to be taken and provide you with initial support.

WHAT YOU CAN DO IMMEDIATELY OR IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS:

1. Request emergency assistance on site or by calling "112"

in the event of an attack on public transport: alert the driver or any other carrier staff or use the emergency call points in the metro.

2. Collect testimonies, if possible, and preserve evidence:

- request the telephone number or e-mail address of witnesses
- ask them to share potential photos and/or videos with you.

3. Filing a complaint:

- on site, in the police mobile station
- at the police station nearest to the site, or nearest to your home or to a gendarmerie brigade:

*In the event of an attack on public transport:

file a complaint within 72 hours at the latest (so that the video images can be saved).

4. Reporting injuries and traumas in the event of aggression (they may be moral and/or physical)

- at the Specialised Reception Centre for Assaults (CASA) located near the emergency department at Rouen University Hospital, if possible after filing a complaint.
